

Resource icon 2022-08-31 Install or remove the virtual camera macOS compatibility If the Start Virtual Camera button isn't showing in the Controls dock, follow these instructions to install the virtual camera. You can also remove the virtual camera if it conflicts with other software. Platform Install Remove Windows in File Explorer, go to C:\Program Files\obs-studio\data\obs-plugins\win-dshow right-click virtualcam-install.bat and select Run as Administrator Follow the instructions at the left, but use virtualcam-uninstall.bat (note the un) instead. If you have installed OBS Studio to a different folder or you are using portable mode: right-click your OBS Studio shortcut and select Open File Location in File Explorer, right-click virtualcam-install.bat and select Run as Administrator macOS (macOS 13.0+) When opening OBS for the first time, you will get a prompt "System Extension Blocked". Click "Open System Settings". Alternatively, open System Settings – Privacy & Security – Security (macOS 13 and 14) or System Settings – General – Login Items & Extensions – Camera Extensions (macOS 15 and later). In the box "System software from application" OBS' was blocked from loading" click "Allow". Authenticate to allow the system extension. Restart OBS. Uninstall OBS Studio to uninstall the virtual camera. macOS (macOS 11 / 12) The virtual camera will be installed when you first click on Start Virtual Camera. Delete /Library/CoreMediaIO/Plug-Ins/DAL/obs-mac-virtualcam.plugin. Linux On Linux, the virtual camera is powered by v4l2loopback. Make sure that v4l2loopback is installed. See the wiki for distribution-specific instructions. macOS compatibility OBS Studio 30.0 and higher running on macOS 13 ("Ventura") and higher include a new virtual camera component that is compatible with all Mac applications. The virtual camera component in OBS 29.1 and earlier is not compatible with macOS 14 ("Sonoma") at all. If you require the virtual camera to work, update to OBS 30.0 (or newer) or stay on macOS 13 ("Ventura"). The version of the virtual camera component used for macOS 12 and prior may be incompatible with some applications. We recommend using the virtual camera with Chromium-based browsers (such as Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge) for best compatibility, especially for online services such as Discord. The Virtual Camera is a feature of OBS Studio that allows you to share your OBS Studio scene with any applications that can make use of a webcam, such as Zoom, Skype, Discord, etc. This feature is particularly useful for applications that cannot capture the screen directly. Using the virtual camera To start the virtual camera, click Start Virtual Camera in the Controls dock. To stop the virtual camera, click the same button again (which will be labelled Stop Virtual Camera). To adjust settings for the virtual camera, click on the ⚙ Gear icon in the Controls dock. From the Virtual Camera settings window, you can adjust the following settings: Program: The virtual camera will show what OBS Studio normally outputs Preview: If using Studio Mode, the virtual camera will show the Preview. This means anybody watching the video feed will see you changing scenes, making edits, etc. Scene: The virtual camera shows only one scene, regardless of what is currently showing in the outputs Source: The virtual camera always shows one source Awaiting approval before being displayed publicly. I think that the key here would be to have the option to offload encoding to the GPU - the CPU figures out the plan, the GPU executes it. I don't know enough to know if it's possible, but I sure hope so, because other than the lag, this is a perfect blur. So this new version works fantastically however it's meant for more powerful GPUs. I have a 1650 and it lags me down to 35 fps in OBS. So watch out for that guys Has anyone got this working on OBS 28? I've tried installing it and it doesn't seem to pop up? Hi, I'm trying to install this on a Win 10 virtual machine. I see the destination path leads to a folder called, "force", but don't see it. I am not a programmer and my host machine is a Mac, so any help would be appreciated. Below are the directions I am following: First, download the zip file: AI_remove_bg.zip file in the OBS directory e.g. C:\Program Files\obs-studio, for example: > Expand-Archive -AI_remove_bg.zip -DestinationPath 'C:\Program Files\obs-studio' -Force Thanks in advance! I've tried two now and this one works the best....EXCEPT when i restart OBS or come back after having been working on other things for awhile, all i get is a black screen. If I stop/start OBS it's no different however if i remove this filter the video comes back. i can then re-add the filter immediately and it works again. Any possibility of this getting fixed?
