Saudi tourist visas are the easiest to get and allow for travel without restrictions in most provinces for up to 90 days. This type of visa is specifically designed for recreational activities, sightseeing visits, and traveling freely within Saudi Arabia. For Muslims, there's the Umrah Visa, which is only valid in specific neighborhoods of Jeddah, Mecca, or Medina and can't be used for leisure trips or work purposes. It's intended solely for performing Umrah outside of the Hajj season. Business and events-related visas have some flexibility: you can visit for business meetings, seminars, conferences, technical visits, startups related short-term meetings, and other commercial activities as long as they don't require signing contracts on-site. These usually last less than 90 days. The Saudi eVisa is valid for tourism, umrah, meetings, conferences, business events, and meeting family members, with each stay limited to 90 days consecutively. Expat Exit Reentry Visa Requirements in Saudi Arabia for Family Members and Returnees Given the rules of exit/re-entry visa, expats who left KSA with an existing visa but did not return within the allotted time frame will face a three-year entrance ban. The employer would have to issue a new visa if the employee doesn't return on schedule. After 2 months, 'exited and didn't return' term is automatically recorded for every Saudi Arabia resident. The rules of exit/re-entry visas in Saudi Arabia apply to both family members and individuals planning to leave and return within a specific time frame. In order to get a definitive exit visa, one must be already residing in Saudi Arabia. Expat individuals who left KSA with an existing Saudi exit/reentry visa but did not return will face a three-year entrance ban. Dependents and accompanying passengers are exempt from this prohibition. Travelers with valid iqama are also excluded. Note that according to Decision No. 825, made in 1395 (Gregorian 1975), individuals disobeying the law would have to pay SR10,000 and be barred from leaving the nation for three years. ###ARTICLETo apply for Saudi Arabia's e-Visa, you'll need to provide personal details such as your passport info, expected arrival and departure dates, purpose of visit, contact information, and payment details.
