So much so that when I saw a similar argument about music ratings and saw some wisdom there, I wanted to share it here. Its not news many of us are rating on different scales. That some people think that a 3/5 is a good score, indicating you liked a book, and others think its a borderline insult. But Ive not seen so much talk about why. There are three different reasons to give a rating I can think of (which probably means theres six more I havent thought of), and I think all of them will adjust what rating you give. They are: a) This is how much I want you to pay attention to thisb) This is how good it is compared to others of its ilkc) This is how much I personally like it The first one is pretty popular these days due to sites like Goodreads and Amazon, where our average gives a book a score. People rate high as thats how you get attention. Its the rating type where 3/5 is a bad score because youve missed out two chances to shout pay attention even louder and the ratings below are mainly used for loudly telling people not to read. The second one is generally beloved by people trying to be measured critics. They dont like giving everything a 5/5 because if everything is a 5/5, how do you differentiate? In these places, a 3/5 is a good respectable score. It means compared to other books in the genre, or in its tone, its worth checking out. A 5/5 should be something special and rare. The third is probably the standard one, but the standard quickly becomes non-standard due to our own personalities. Some people get super-excited about stuff and really like most books. Some people have very strong opinions on what makes good fiction and a huge list of internal comparisons and dont. And all sorts of things in between. The thing is, none of these are bad underlying motivations for giving a rating. Ive done all of them at one time or another. They just lack cohesion. There are undoubtedly books that Id give a 5 on Goodreads to draw attention to it, a 3 if writing for a place that insisted on stringent scoring, and something akin to a 4 in my personal ratings (I used letters, not numbers, to create a deliberate sense of difference). Theres probably quite a lot of them actually. Is there anything wrong with that? I dont think so providing everyone knows the score but obviously, not everyone does. Hence the arguments. It would be foolish and wrong to ask everyone to use the same rationale behind review scores. But I think a greater awareness that were not might help everyone a little bit at times.
